ADVISORY

This is to inform all stakeholders, residents, guests, and employees that Subic Bay Freeport Zone Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) is temporarily restricting the entry of individuals to prevent spread of COVID-19 within the zone, except for:

1. Subic Bay Freeport Residents, provided that, residents who come from Metro Manila and other areas which have local COVID-19 transmission shall undergo mandatory self-quarantine for fourteen (14) days under the supervision of the Public Health and Safety Department (PHSD);
2. Subic Bay Freeport Zone locators, employees, students, accredited service providers, logistics enterprise delivering and picking up goods or supplies, port users (only their cargo trucks) government employees, suppliers, infrastructure and emergency service personnel shall be allowed, provided that they exhibit no sign or symptoms of possible COVID-19 infection and shall exit the Freeport on the same day of their entry.
3. Such other individuals specifically allowed by the SBMA to enter Subic Bay Freeport Zone.

Affected individuals passing through SBMA will have to use alternate routes to and from Anvaya. An alternative route is via Bagac (JJ Linao Highway) – Morong Bataan.

This took effect at 12:00 am of March 16, 2020 until April 14, 2020 or until the State of Public Health Emergency ends, or is lifted, whichever comes first.

INITIATIVES

In relation to the Government's efforts to control the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), we would like to assure everyone that your Administration is proactively implementing mitigating measures to prevent the spread of the disease within Anvaya Cove and complies with standards prescribed by DOH.

1. Mandatory Temperature screening for everyone entering Anvaya Cove.
2. Availability of Hand sanitizers in strategic locations within the property.
3. Increased frequency of disinfection of virus-prone surfaces, including common area doors knobs and handles, restrooms, elevators and elevator buttons, railings, and other common areas.
4. Conduct of regular awareness campaigns for property staff, for the application of contingency measures relative to any potential COVID-19-related situation.
5. Regular coordination with Department of Health, Local Government Unit, and other concerned agencies.
6. Package screening and disinfection.

May we also seek your support and cooperation in observing the following Protocols:

- Persons coming to Anvaya Cove from other country/area with confirmed COVID-19 case must observe strict self-quarantine for a period of 14 days upon arrival. This must be reported and coordinated to the Administration or directly to the designated Barangay Health Emergency Team for proper monitoring.
- Move-ins: All individuals moving-in shall be required to secure medical clearances.
- Practice social distancing
- Avoid non-essential travels
- No Construction Works and Renovation
