ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE

Extended Until May 15, 2020

in Metro Manila, Calabarzon, Central Luzon, and all other High-Risk Areas

President Rodrigo Duterte has extended the enhanced community quarantine to stop the spread of COVID-19 in Metro Manila, Central Luzon and CALABARZON **until May 15**.

Duterte's decision was announced by presidential spokesperson Harry Roque in a televised briefing aired Friday morning.

Duterte also accepted the recommendation of the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases to extend until May 15 the ECQ in similarly high-risk areas Pangasinan, Benguet, Mindoro island, Albay and Catanduanes.

The ECQ will also be imposed until May 15 in Antique, Iloilo, Cebu and Cebu City, Aklan and Capiz in the Visayas and Davao del Norte, Davao City and Davao de Oro in Mindanao. These are also considered high-risk in connection with the spread of COVID-19.
