## ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE VS GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Philippine National Government announced on April 24 that the Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) is extended in Metro Manila, Central Luzon, CALABARZON, and all other high-risk areas until May 15. Meanwhile, a General Community Quarantine (GCQ) will be enforced in low-risk and moderate-risk areas until mid-May.
