# SECTORS, ACTIVITIES **BANNED** IN AREAS UNDER ECQ AND GCQ

Beginning May 1, 2020, the government will ease some coronavirus lockdown rules in areas deemed to have a low to moderate risk to COVID-19 infection. These areas will be placed under the so-called **General Community Quarantine (GCQ)** while areas with “high-risk” COVID-19 infections will stay under **Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ)** until May 15.

While some economic activities will be allowed in areas under GCQ in a limited capacity, there are still services and sectors that will not be allowed to continue operation. As presented by Presidential spokesman Harry Roque in his Tuesday’s online press briefing in Malacañang, the following activities and services will not be allowed to resume both in areas under ECQ and GCQ:
