## SBMA ADVISORY (NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC)

In line with the strict border control measures implemented by the Subic Bay Metropolitan Authority (SBMA) on April 1, 2020, further restriction will be enforced at Subic Bay Freeport Zone (SBFZ) gates starting Monday, April 6, 2020 as follows:

- 1. Rizal Gate and Morong Gate** — Only for persons and vehicles allowed access to SBFZ such as:
  - a. SBMA employees on duty and their vehicles;
  - b. Employees of establishments that are allowed by SBMA to continue to operate and their vehicles;
  - c. Medical professionals and their vehicles;
  - d. Holders of IATF IDs and their vehicles;
  - e. Employees of government agencies with offices, facilities or equipment inside the Freeport and their vehicles;
  - f. Members of law enforcement agencies and their vehicles;
  - g. Members of emergency response units and their vehicles;
  - h. Freeport residents with an SBMA Medical Pass or a Travel Pass issued by the PNP or an LGU.
  - i. Government vehicles with business that cannot be delayed.
- 2. Tipo Gate** — Only for vehicles allowed access to SBFZ such as vehicles transporting:
  - a. SBMA employees on duty;
  - b. Employees of Freeport establishments that are allowed to continue to operate;
  - c. Medical professionals;
  - d. Holders of IATF IDs;
  - e. Employees of government agencies with offices, facilities or equipment inside the Freeport;
  - f. Members of law enforcement agencies;
  - g. Members of emergency response units;
  - h. Freeport residents with a Medical Travel Pass or a Travel Pass issued by the PNP or an LGU;
  - g. Delivery trucks of essential commodities allowed under the IATF memo such as but not limited to food, medicines, fuel/petroleum, and the like;
  - h. Other cargo and delivery trucks in consonance with the IATF memo of unimpeded movement of cargo;
  - i. Government vehicles with business that cannot be delayed; and
  - j. Waste management/disposal vehicles.
- 3. Kalayaan Gate** — Only for emergency vehicles (ambulance, fire truck, LED vehicles) that are responding to an actual emergency, vehicles with an emergency medical patient on board and SBMA vehicles transporting SBMA employees to and from official duty.
- 4. Kalaklan Gate** — PARTIALLY CLOSED.  
Only SBMA vehicles, vehicles for delivery (including petroleum trucks), vehicles of medical professionals, official service vehicles of law enforcement agencies, and official service vehicles of utility services are allowed.  
4(a). Kalaklan Pedestrian Gate — PARTIALLY CLOSED.  
Only for SBMA employees on duty, employees of open SBF establishments, medical professionals, and individuals needing emergency medical care.
- 5. Main Gate fronting Magsaysay Avenue** — CLOSED
- 6. 14th Street Gate** — CLOSED
