EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14
Series of 2020

"AN ORDER IMPLEMENTING A LIMITED, CALIBRATED AND TARGETED LOCKDOWN IN SITIO RELOCATION AND ANVAYA COVE, BARANGAY SABANG, MORONG, BATAAN"

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 stipulates that every local government unit shall promote the welfare of the general public;

WHEREAS, it is alarming that the number of cases of positive in COVID-19 in the municipality, particularly in Sitio Relocation and Anvaya Cove, Sabang still continue to surge as of this date;

WHEREAS, due to the unique and vulnerable situation of the said areas, this measure is highly needed and necessary;

WHEREAS, this Executive Order was only issued as an extreme and last resort measure and not for convenience;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CYNTHIA G. LINAO-ESTANISLAO, M.D., Municipal Mayor of Morong, Bataan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order to "Implement A Limited, Calibrated and Targeted Lockdown in Sitio Relocation and Anvaya Cove, Sabang, Morong, Bataan".

Section 1. **AREAS COVERED AND EFFECTIVITY OF THE LOCKDOWN AND ACCESS POINT**- The Lockdown shall cover and is limited to residents of Sitio Relocation and Anvaya Cove, Sabang, Morong, Bataan, and will be effective from October 8, 2020 at 6:00AM up to 11:59PM of October 11, 2020.

Section 2. **TASK FORCE** - In order to have smooth and lawful implementation of the said lockdown, a task force is hereby being formed to be composed of the following, to wit:

Chairman:	The Municipal Mayor
Co-Chairman:	The Punong-Barangay
Action Officer:	The Chief of Police or his Designated Officer
Vice-Chairman Officer:	The Municipal Health Officer or his Designated Officer

Members:	The Local Government Operations Officer or his Designated Officer (Administration)
	The Municipal Social Worker or her Designated Officer (Relief Operations)
	The Municipal Engineer
	The Municipal DRRMO
	The Municipal General Services Officer or his Designated Officer (Logistics and Transportation)
	Chief (Barangay Tanod) (Security and Checkpoints)
	ALL BARANGAY COUNCILORS (Policies and Implementation)

Section 3. **GENERAL GUIDELINES** - The following guidelines regarding the implementation of the lockdown will be as follows:

- I. No person shall be allowed to go out of their residence and a 24-hour curfew in effect on all residence as a general rule;
- II. All individuals which cater to basic need will be allowed to operate from 6:00AM to 12:00NN within the lockdown area but under the following conditions:

- a. Their suppliers must replenish their supplies in the Access Points only;
 - b. In dealing with customers, they must implement the minimum health standards as mandated by earlier executive orders of the undersigned and higher national government authorities;
 - c. They must secure an "Authority to Conduct Business under Lockdown Area" from the Punong-Barangay
 - d. All other transactions such as supplies of water, goods, deliveries and others will be conducted in the Access Point only under the supervision of the Task Force
- III. All persons employed outside the lockdown area will have the following options:
- a. Have them to undergo swabbing and be tested under the RT-PCR tests as mandated by the guidelines of the National Government;
 - b. Have themselves registered in the barangay so that the Municipal Government of Morong, Bataan can communicate with their employers regarding the situation, or
 - c. Stay on their current areas of employment or other areas;
- IV. The following are exempted from the "stay at home" order under this mandate:
- a. Those who will buy or procure basic necessities such as but not limited to purchase of medicines, food and other essentials, as per the time allotted;
 - b. Emergency situations and routine medical check-ups or urgent concerns (e.g. dialysis, etc.); and
 - c. Other situations which will be left on the best judgment of the Action Officer or his authorized representative;
- V. The contact tracing, testing and other relative operations will be conducted immediately upon the start of the lockdown;
- VI. Other policies will be issued by the Task Force during the implementation of the lockdown;

Section 4 – **COMPLIANCE** – On or before October 8, 2020, the undersigned will submit all relevant documentations to the proper authorities to substantiate the legality of this Order.

Section 5 – **PENALTY** – Individuals who will be caught in violation of this Executive Order will be punished by the provisions of Republic Act No. 11332 and other relative laws and ordinances of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Bataan and the Sangguniang Bayan of Morong, Bataan.

Section 6. – **REPEALING CLAUSE** – All laws, ordinances, executive orders that are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modified.

Section 7 - **SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If any part of this Executive Order is declared invalid, the part not affected by such will remain valid.

Section 8 – **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE** – This Executive Order is effective immediately.
