To Whom it may Concern,

This is to inform your good office that we will not be able to provide the usual water potability test result for the month of April 2020. Due to the strict implementation of Enhanced Community Quarantine nationwide, all laboratories, including EICHEM, our Laboratory Service Provider, temporarily closed and stopped operating in compliance with the government mandate.


Be assured that despite our laboratory not being able to conduct the potability test, our team is simultaneously conducting monthly internal testing activities to ensure everyone safe and potable water supply as an alternative.

For your reference, I have attached here the data of our chlorine residual for the month of April 2020 which were taken from our reservoirs with their corresponding parameters and results as well.

We made the best effort to look for all possible ways to conduct our usual water potability testing for the month April 2020, however, with the strict implementation of ECQ, we were still not able to realize it. But upon transitioning from ECQ to MECQ last May 15, 2020, all laboratories have already resumed operating. Last May 26, our laboratory service provider was able to do their water sampling. With this, we can now provide you the result by next month.

We look forward for your understanding and continued support.
